THE AWARDS

LONG-TIME (DEDICATED) SERVICE AWARD

Eligibility

OACUSA Executive Member/Director/Chair

Criteria

This award is intended to honour an OACUSA Executive member/Director/Chair who hold positions for extended periods of time. Example of service to be recognized:. Has participated on the OACUSA executive in various roles over the course of 10 years. Demonstrates a commitment to the association and the betterment of security and emergency management in the post-secondary setting.

Presentation

Award recipient will receive a plaque and will be recognized at the annual Spring Conference.

OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT/INITIATIVE AWARD

Eligibility

Any OACUSA member, team, sub-committee, contract security team member or partners.

Criteria

This award is intended to honour a member/team/sub-committee who in the previous 12 months has developed a new initiative that will enhance the image/reputation of the team and/or advance the departments goals and/or build partnerships and/or reduce costs and demonstrates strong leadership. This initiative is not a core function of the nominee's role. All of these elements will be considered for the award selection.

Presentation

Award recipients will receive a plaque and will be recognized at the annual Spring Conference.

EMERGING LEADER AWARD

Eligibility

OACUSA associate members.



Criteria

This award is intended to honour an Associate member who consistently demonstrates outstanding effective leadership skills, both within and beyond the scope of their responsibilities. This member demonstrates a high level of integrity and honesty, ability to communicate well, handle conflict effectively, respectful and appreciates differing views, team oriented, collaborates, shares information and knowledge, motivates others, and has a willingness to learn and develop their skills.

This OACUSA associate member is engaged in the post-secondary security/EM fields and have made a significant contribution to the team. Has completed 5 years with an OACUSA institution and has not received this award previously.

Presentation

Awards recipients will receive a plaque and will be recognized at the annual Spring Conference.

INNOVATIONS IN COMMUNITY-ORIENTED POLICING/COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

Eligibility

OACUSA institutional Department, individual employee, team or unit.

Criteria

This award is for outstanding service and initiative supporting the effective promotion of the Community Oriented Policing philosophy. New and innovative ideas, demonstrated significant impact of an evidence-based crime prevention program or initiative, and development of strong community partnerships programs are some of the elements that will be considered for award selection.

Presentation

Awards recipients will receive a plaque and will be recognized at the annual Spring Conference.

HEROISM AWARD

Eligibility

OACUSA member within campus public safety, special constables or security department, or individual employee, team or unit of the member institution.

Criteria

Performed an act of service of a rare or exceptional nature and/or demonstrated unusual heroism and skill in saving or attempting to save life and that reflects an uncommon degree of concern for the wellbeing of others at considerable risk to their personal health and safety.



Presentation

Awards recipients will receive a plaque and will be recognized at the annual Spring Conference.

PRESIDENT'S RECOGNITION AWARD

Eligibility

This award may be presented to any member of OACUSA

Criteria

The OACUSA President may select an OACUSA member to recognize them for their work where the President (in consultation with the Executive) deems it appropriate to recognize their actions/efforts for the betterment of OACUSA and the campus safety/security profession. This member will have worked to develop industry standards, best practices and demonstrated an openness to discuss and share information and common concerns in an effort to making our campuses safe and secure.

Presentation

Awards recipients will receive a plaque and will be recognized at the annual Spring Conference.

AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

Eligibility

This award may be presented to any member of OACUSA

Criteria

This member has demonstrated excellence through a variety of ways. From helping other OACUSA members to grow, encouraging others to continue to grow, learn and challenge themselves. This individual has contributed to their institution and OACUSA through their work which embodies OACUSA's values; engagement, advocacy, partnerships and professional standards. This individual demonstrates their sincere appreciation towards their team and OACUSA members and values every individuals' contributions.

Presentation

The Award of Excellence recipient will receive a Glass trophy Award and will be recognized at the OACUSA Annual Conference.
