### Forensic Experiential Trauma-Informed Interviewing® - Carrie Hull & Angela Fleischer

### Workplace Institute: Investigations Training - Gareth Jones

The presentation dissects the investigation by the RCMP of a fatal police shooting that, like every other investigation, was less than perfect. The death was the subject of a judicial Commission of Inquiry that received national attention, as was the investigation. The focus of the presentation Is whether the investigation met fundamental investigative principles that apply to any kind of investigation. It discusses the thoroughness of the evidence gathering process, the quality of investigative interviews and objectivity throughout the investigation.

## North American Center for Threat Assessment and Trauma Response (NACTATR) – Kevin Cameron

The fields of Violence Threat Risk Assessment (VTRA) and Crisis-Trauma Response are inseparably connected. A worldwide pandemic has demonstrated how high-profile and protracted trauma can intensify symptom development in individuals and entire systems. This includes an intensification in violence and suicidality. This presentation will unfold the effects of the pandemic on post-pandemic mental health by expanding on the effects of quarantine and the reality that high-profile trauma does not generally create new dynamics in human systems but instead intensifies already existing ones. From the aftermath of the George Floyd tragedy to the "Freedom Convoys" and beyond, these dynamics are being duplicated in our post-secondary communities and they can be successfully address through trauma-informed leadership and skillful multidisciplinary collaboration.
